

2023 Golf Guest Information

The Members and Staff of River Bend are delighted to host you at our club. Our intention is to provide a first-class golf experience at River Bend. The staff is committed to making your visit a pleasurable one and with that in mind we would like to share with you some guidelines to make your visit more enjoyable.

Arrival:

You will find our staff at the bag drop near the breezeway entrance in the front of the clubhouse. From the bag drop, our staff can direct you to the locker room, pro shop, and golf practice facility. Guests should not change their shoes or clothes in the parking lot. Please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time to allow ample time to prepare to play as well as to ensure a prompt start to your round.

Our Pro Shop accepts credit card, checks and member charge as a method of payment for any merchandise that guests may wish to purchase.

Attire:

Our dress code requires collared shirts or mock turtlenecks, slacks, or shorts. Shorts are to be no more than two inches above the knee. Jeans and other denim clothing are not allowed on the golf course or practice facility. Gentlemen are required to remove hats while in the clubhouse. Hats should be worn forward and shirts tucked in. No golf shoes are allowed in the clubhouse except in the locker rooms.

Lockers:

A member of the Golf Professional Staff will show you to the locker room and assist you with a locker if you require one. Both Ladies and Men's Locker Rooms have changing and shower facilities.

Pace of Play:

A round of golf at River Bend takes four hours. Please be prepared to maintain this standard. Ready golf is always encouraged. The Golf Professional Staff will monitor pace of play throughout the round, but the hosting member is always responsible for their guests and the pace of play for any groups that they are hosting.

Cell Phones:

The use of cellular phones and other electronic communications devices are not permitted in any dining areas or common areas frequented by Members. Please be courteous and use your cell phone outside or in a private area. Please have your cell phone on vibrate on the course.

Golf Course Care:

Please use the sand mix provided on your cart to repair all divots on the tees, fairway and the rough. Sand mix is also provided for those walking the course. Please repair all ball marks, rake all bunkers, leave the rakes outside the bunker, and kindly remove sand from your spikes upon leaving the bunkers. Also please exit all bunkers on the lower side farthest from the green. Specific cart restrictions will be provided on your day of play.

Smoking Policy:

The entire indoor facility of River Bend Golf and Country Club is smoke free, except for the locker rooms. Smoking is permissible on the golf course. Please be courteous and dispose of cigarette and cigar butts in proper garbage receptacles.
